However, when he got to know that she was pregnant with twins, he ran away and she doesn't know his whereabouts. The twins, Eric and Evans are five months old. Rehema loves little children. She hopes that when she learns tailoring, she will work hard to buy her own sewing machine so that she can start a business and be able to take care of her children and also help fellow girls who are going through the same situation.



Betty is twenty one and comes from Kigoogwa, Wakiso district. Her father abandoned their family when she was in senior one and she stopped going to school. She started working on a farm planting trees but later got pregnant. She stayed with the boyfriend for a while but he ran away leaving her all alone. She then went and started living with her paternal aunt until this day. She has been working as a housemaid. Her son Ronnie is two years old. Betty loves cooking and looking after children. She hopes to start her own business in future so that she can be able to take care of her child.

Joweria is eighteen and comes from Masaka district but she is now staying with her maternal aunt in Kigoogwa town. She was in her senior two December holidays when she got pregnant. She stopped going to school and stayed home with her parents until she gave birth. Her son Hakusha is two years old. The father of her son helps to take care of him when he can. She loves taking care of others. She hopes to work hard and become a big business owner in the future.



Mackline is twenty three years old and comes from Kigoogwa, Wakisa district. She is an orphan and the first born of seven children. She is also a mother of twins - Titus and Joy and they are one year and ten months. She studied until senior four but stopped continuing with school due to the loss of her parents. She later got pregnant but the boyfriend abandoned her and she doesn't know his whereabouts. She loves working hard at any odd job to earn money for her children. She hopes to start a tailoring business after her training and also desires to pass on her learned skill to other girls.
