

"Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it and it will be yours" Mark 11:24.

PRAYER IS TALKING TO GOD.

How can you get to know someone you have just meet? You have to talk to him for your friendship to grow stronger. If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior and Lord – He is now your friend and you need to talk to Him continuously to get to know Him better. Jesus also prayed while He was on Earth, we ought to pray too in order to live victorious lives too on earth.

You cannot see God when you talk to Him but He is there with you always.

God is never too busy for you; He is always ready to listen to you. He knows and understands you completely. You can talk to God all the time. He wants you to talk to Him all the time (1Thessalonians 5:17, Philippians 4:6).

You can talk to God in the morning, noon, night and any time in between.

You can pray while you are doing something else like doing house work, walking or playing. There is never a bad time to pray. You can pray anywhere - at home, church, school outside, on a tree etc. It's only God who can hear and answer your prayers. Jesus taught His Disciples how to pray- The Lord's prayer (Luke 11:3-4).

We pray because our lives are TOTALLY DEPENDANT ON GOD ALONE FOR EVERY ASPECT OF OUR LIVES.

Pray about anything in and around your life and lives of others. Tell Him how wonderful He is, thank Him for what He has done for you, ask Him to forgive you of your sin, tell Him about things that make you happy. Talk to Him about your feelings and things that worry you (Psalms 55:22), tell Him about things that you cannot tell anyone else. Ask Him to help you know Him better. After all, God is the only one who has power to help you in all your needs and problems. God wants you to pray for other people's needs too e.g. family, friends, community, Uganda to especially come to know Jesus ad Lord and Savior (James 5:16).

God will answer your prayers.

When you pray in faith, believe that He has provided. In the bible God says "Call to me and I will answer you" Jeremiah 33:3" Sometimes He will say YES and give you what you ask for if it's in His will, sometimes He might say NO or say WAIT because it might not be the right time to give you what you ask for. Don't pray with wrong motives, you will not receive answer to prayer. Always remember God knows what is best for you.

Jesus tells us to ask and we will receive in His Name for our joy to be complete (John 16:24)

So that the Son may bring glory to the Father (John 14:13). In order to have powerful, effective prayers, we must pray according to God's will not asking selfishly but praying in faith and confessing our sin regularly.
